

Stenograph Updates iCVNet to 2.0

New Version Adds Adjustable Font Sizes

November 2, 2015 – Elmhurst, IL - Stenograph® today updated the iCVNet™ realtime viewing software for the Apple iPad® to version 2.0. Users can now “pinch” their screens to adjust the size of the fonts, or select the font size from the menu button that appears across the top of the screen.

“When a court reporter is setting up for realtime, they can now pre-select a font size that the recipient will use to view the transcript on the iPad,” remarks James Kuta, Stenograph Product Manager. “At any time, the recipient can adjust the font size by pinching the text or selecting the font size from the menu button. The ability to adjust the font size helps ensure a comfortable viewing experience for the recipients.”

Stenograph’s iCVNet iPad app provides attorneys and judges instant viewing of realtime deposition and trial transcripts on an iPad. Court reporters using Case CATalyst software can send the realtime text via a wireless network, and via an Internet connection. Court reporters using any CAT software can send the realtime text via an Internet connection. Attorneys and legal professionals can connect to the reporter’s secure WiFi network or secure Internet stream to receive, view, mark, search and email the transcript. Once connected, the entire transcript is displayed, even if connecting after testimony has started.
